

Alcohol and Other Drugs Policy

Sydney Karate Club is committed to provide a safe and healthy sports environment.

We recognize that alcohol or drug misuse will impair an individual's ability to perform in a safe manner.

It is the policy of Sydney Karate Club to protect its members, assets, the community and the environment in which it operates from hazards arising from alcohol or drug misuse.

Consequently, we require the performance of anyone within the Sydney Karate Club organisation whether a member, competitor, family, friend etc. and others to be unimpaired by drug or alcohol misuse whilst associated with any type of activities to do with Sydney Karate Club. The legal or unauthorized possession, consumption, sale or being under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs during any type of activity for Sydney Karate Club is prohibited.

We view drug or alcohol dependency as a medical condition and encourage any member, non-member or anyone associated with Sydney Karate Club with a problem to seek confidential support and treatment.

Any person/s associated with Sydney Karate Club found to be in breach of this policy shall be subject to removal from any events associated with Sydney Karate Club.

The above policy is subject to anyone wishing to be in any part of business associated with Sydney Karate Club.

Sydney Karate Club abides to the MAIA and ISKA Anti-doping policies.
