

Health and Safety Policy/Risk Management Statement

1. This policy recognises that the health and safety of all Sydney Karate Club members or employees is the responsibility of all in maintaining a healthy and safe environment within the organisation.
2. Sydney Karate Club acknowledges its legal, moral and social responsibility to provide a healthy and safe training/workspace, and to secure the health and safety of its employees, members and visitors.
3. All members involved with Sydney Karate Club must provide and maintain a safe training environment and equipment within the organisation.
4. It is the responsibility of all within Sydney Karate Club to recognize the hazards occurring within the organisation, Sydney Karate Club will take every practical step to provide and maintain a safe and healthy environment for its members.
5. Members who run their own clubs and are in charge of their own training facilities are:
Responsible for the effective implementation of their company or dojo training facilities.
Health and safety policy must be observed, implemented and fulfil its responsibilities under the acts and regulations that apply to Sydney Karate Club.
Must make regular assessments of safety performances within their clubs facilities.
Must provide clear training instructions to all its members to limit risk of any injuries.
6. Students or Members within the Sydney Karate Club organisation have a duty to take the care of which they are capable for their own health and safety and others. affected by their actions at training or when competing at tournaments.
Shall comply with the safety procedures and directions agreed within the Dojo rules.
Must not interfere with or misuse items or facilities provided in the interests of health, safety and welfare for all within the organisation.
7. Sydney Karate Club reserves the right to carry its own Risk Assessment with its members to achieve a health and safe environment within the organisation.
8. Sydney Karate Club abides by the ISKA/MAIA/Work cover Risk Management Policies.
Sydney Karate Club reserves the right to review their policy and change in accordance to meet Government Regulation.
